Presently, we own 135 properties located in Québec, Ontario and Saskatchewan. We are currently seeking exploration geologists to join our exploration team with gold, base metal and/or uranium exploration experience for our on-going 2008 field programs. Golden Valley Mines' three principal project areas include the Abitibi (Québec-Ontario) grassroots diamond drill program, the James Bay Cheechoo project near the "Éléonore" gold development project and the Otish Basin area uranium joint venture.

JUNIOR EXPLORATION GEOLOGISTS

Reporting to the senior project geologist, the successful candidate's responsibilities may include the daily management of various exploration or drill projects, geological mapping and interpretation, prospecting, geochemical surveying, and the compilation and processing of geological data.

Suitable candidates should have a Bachelor's degree in Geology and have 1-5 years experience in the exploration for gold, base metals and/or uranium, including working in remote field situations, be independent, self-reliant with a complement of academic and/or industry references and proven interpersonal skills. The ideal candidates will also be well-rounded with a strong background in ore deposit models and mineral exploration methodologies. Professional registration and practical experience in GIS data systems, corelogging and data management software is also essential. Bilingual French and English is preferred, but not a prerequisite for all the positions.

The positions would include approximately 5 months of fieldwork per year, with the remaining time based in our Val-d'Or office.
